

Yellow Bag information

from the waste management of the county of Kaiserslautern



From January 2022 a new company is in charge of the distribution and collection of yellow bags. It is the company Containerdienst B&S GmbH, which works in our county on behalf of the Dual System Interseroh+ GmbH.

Initial distribution:

A basic quantity of yellow bags is distributed each year (usually between Nov. and Feb.). Each household will get 60 bags in total.

Complaints and responsibility:

If you did not receive any bags at the basic distribution or should you have any complaint because the yellow bags have not been collected, kindly contact the company at the **toll-free hotline: 0800 - 00 10 227**.

Please note, that the waste management office of the county administration is not responsible for complaints.

Use of yellow bags:

Yellow bags may only be used for the disposal of sales packaging made of plastic, metal or composite materials. Using yellow bags for other purposes is an administrative offense.



WHAT GOES IN THE YELLOW BAG?

Plastics

Foils e.g. bags, pouches, cling film, bottles e.g. for detergents, toiletry, beverages, cups e.g. for margarine or yogurt (remove aluminum lids), foamed material e.g. styrofoam packaging, foamed wrappings

Metals

Empty spray cans, tin and beverage cans, aluminum lids or foil, bottle caps

Composite materials

Beverage cartons, coffee packaging, vacuum packs

WHAT DOES NOT GO IN THE YELLOW BAG?

Glass, paper, cardboard
Packaging with contents e.g. spoiled food
Foamed materials e.g. chair cushions
Records, cassettes, CDs/DVDs
Plastic pipes
Insulating foams e.g. polystyrene, styrofoam
Pieces of carpet flooring
Wallpaper
Leather products
Plastic household items and toys
Bicycle tires, water hoses

Things to know about the yellow bag:

Put items in the bag one by one. Make sure that different materials do not stick together. Remove the aluminum foil from plastic cups. Collect only empty packaging and wrappings. Packaging with food leftovers are non-recyclable waste. Packaging containing pollutant substances must be taken to the hazardous waste truck.

Principals:

Yellow bags are not distributed and collected on behalf of the Kaiserslautern county administration. Consequently, these services are not included in the waste fees. The yellow bag is being financed exclusively by the dual systems in Germany.
